7. **gorge**

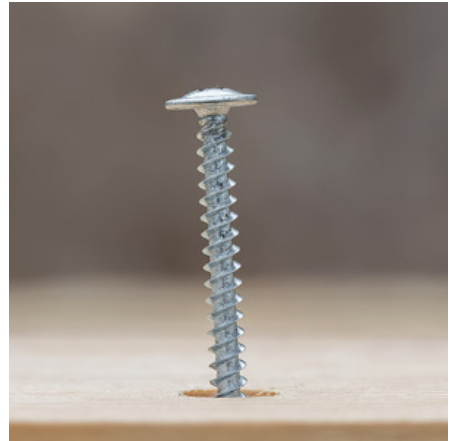


(n) A narrow passage between steep cliffs.
