(v) 1. To give shelter to; to take care of by hiding.

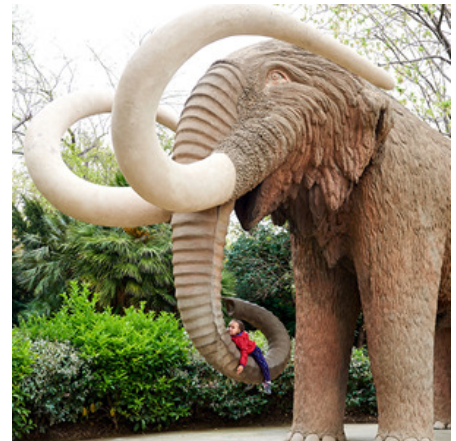
2. To hold and nourish a thought or feeling in the mind.
